William Reagan – Route 542 – I would like a no pass zone in front of the Lower Bank Tavern on Route 542.

Barbara Cavileer – River Road - suggested that it might be better for the Township delegation to go to the County's Engineer's Office to address the state of the county roads.

Horace Somes – Turtle Creek Road – commented about the condition of Route 542 and he was sending pictures to the Clerk concerning flooding along this road.

Barry Cavileer – River Road – made comments about the conditions along Route 542 and that the Township should wait a month to go to the Freeholder's meeting.
