Committeeman Seybold – Took a trip around town with regards to the trees and spoke with Larry with regards to this. He will get together with the Engineer to discuss the problem areas. Public Works has been cutting grass and brush, cold patching and taking care of Godfrey Bridge Road. Larry purchased reflectors for certain areas to make where the plows should be. Public Works trucks are being serviced. Larry would like to meet with David Simpson to discuss OEM issues/concerns.

Deputy Mayor Cavileer – I have a complaint about the trash hauler, not picking up the dumpsters. We may need to go out to bid for this service. I attended the Planning Board meeting in September and the October meeting has been cancelled. The Senior Luncheon is scheduled for 12/4/2018 at 11:30 AM at Fred & Ethel's in Smithville. Next Tuesday will be Workshop Meeting.

Mayor Lewis – I believe that our new OEM David Simpson would like to say something.

David Simpson – I've been going through the files; last week I attended my first meeting with the County and I have other meetings this week and next. I have started organizing supplies.

Mayor Lewis – The Wading River Bridge should be finished by Thursday or Friday and there will no weight limit. We sold three pieces of equipment through Gov Deals.

Ron Hill – Bulltown Road – The intersection of Route 563 & 542 needs to be looked at. People are not stopping. I spoke with the County Engineer and he didn't want to address this issue.

Horace Somes – Turtle Creek Road – The ditching and culverts on River Road haven't been connected. Thirteen culverts were put in on Turtle Creek Road. They ran out of grass seed on Turtle Creek Road. The issue on the Wading River Bridge is the steel grated span. This is not for skinny tires of the bicycles and it's slippery.

Mayor Lewis – I have spoken with Scott Brown about the issues on Turtle Creek Road.

Deputy Mayor Cavileer – Horace brought up a very good point, maybe they should get off the bikes and walk over the bridge.

Mayor Lewis – Most bridges are posted of the danger.

Deputy Mayor Cavileer – Route 563 & 542 have been a problem and another spot is Lower Bank Bridge. We may need a stop sign on the bridge or a 3 way stop.

Township Clerk Hoffman – The County has been notified and is working on a study. Ill have to ask the County about the issue of the intersection of Route 563 & 542.

Committeeman Seybold – Several cars have run that intersection.
