No paper plates, towels, tissues, or napkins. No wrapping paper with foil or glitter.

Plastic Bottles & Food Containers

1 2 & 5 Screw-top caps on plastic bottles are OK.



Glass Bottles & Jars

No ceramics or glassware.

EMPTY and RINSE all bottles, jars, and containers.

DO NOT CRUSH plastic bottles or metal cans



Metal CANS Only No paint or aerosol cans.

How to Prepare



Recyclables should be clean, dry, and empty.



NEVER bag recyclables. Place them loose in your cart.



Recycling should be at the curb by 6am on collection day.



Cardboard must be emptied, flattened, folded and placed in recycling container or stacked neatly and loosely next to it.

Pizza Box Guidelines Pizza boxes must be clean and empty. A **small** amount of grease is okay.
